NEW LAW 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5026.2 of Title 63, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall provide coverage under 18 the state Medicaid program for breast pumps dispensed pursuant to a 19 valid prescription by a physician, physician assistant, or advanced 20 practice registered nurse including manual pumps, electric pumps, or 21 battery-powered pumps. The state Medicaid program shall cover one 22 breast pump per pregnancy including tubing or other necessary parts. 23 A breast pump must meet minimum specifications prescribed by the 24

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    Authority in order to qualify for reimbursement. The Authority
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    shall seek any federal approval necessary to implement this section.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
