14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-149.10 of Title 70, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. Upon service of notice of an action filed for a violation of
18	a student's or school employee's religious liberties or upon receipt
19	of a written or electronic communication expressing an intent to
20	file such action, a school district board of education shall notify
21	the State Department of Education.
22	B. Upon receipt of a notification required by subsection A of
23	this section, the State Department of Education:

1	1. Shall investigate the allegations contained in the action or
2	written or electronic communication; and
3	2. May provide the Department's legal services to the school
4	district board of education.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
