SENATE BILL 1899

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle,
Dismantler, and Manufactured Housing Commission;
prohibiting individuals from operating in this state
without licensure; providing penalties for violation;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 589 of Title 47, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person who installs a manufactured home without first
obtaining an installer's license in this state shall be fined Five
Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00). Each day the disobedience or
violation continues shall constitute a separate and additional
contempt and shall be punished by separate and additional fines each
in an amount not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
