7	An Act relating to students; amending 70 O.S. 2021, Section 13-116, which relates to corporal punishment;
8	prohibiting school personnel from using specific types of corporal punishment on students identified
9	with certain disability; providing types of disabilities; prohibiting a disability from including
10	a reason for placement on certain plan; removing language regarding a written consent waiver; removing
11	definition; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 13-116, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 13-116. A. School district personnel shall be
18	prohibited from using corporal punishment of hitting, slapping,
19	paddling, or any other means of inflicting physical pain on students
20	identified with the most significant cognitive disabilities
21	according to criteria established by the State Department of
22	Education unless addressed in an annual a disability under state and
23	federal regulations that result in the student being on an
24	individualized education program (IEP) developed in accordance with

1	the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). For the
2	purposes of this section, a disability includes autism, deaf-
3	blindness, deafness, emotional disturbance, hearing impairment,
4	intellectual disability, multiple disabilities, orthopedic
5	impairment, other health impairment, specific learning disability,
6	speech or language impairment, traumatic brain injury, and visual
7	impairment including blindness, as defined by Section 18-109.5 of
8	this title. A disability shall not include a reason for which a
9	student may be placed on a Section 504 Plan as defined by the
10	Rehabilitation Act of 1973.
11	B. A waiver to the provisions of subsection A of this section
12	shall be granted if the parent or legal guardian of a student
13	provides written consent.
14	C. As used in this section, "corporal punishment" means the
15	deliberate infliction of physical pain by hitting, paddling,
16	spanking, slapping or any other physical force used as a means of
17	discipline.
18	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
19	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20	of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
21	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
