12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-502.5 of Title 63, unless
14	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. As used in this section, "COVID-19" means the 2019 novel
16	coronavirus disease and any variants of the disease.
17	B. A state agency or political subdivision may not implement,
18	order, or otherwise impose a mandate requiring:
19	1. A person to wear a face mask or other face covering to
20	prevent the spread of COVID-19;
21	2. A person to be vaccinated against COVID-19; or
22	3. The closure of a private business, public school, or private
23	school to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
