SENATE BILL 540

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to bail bondsmen; amending 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1308, which relates to bail bondsmen application processing; removing requirement for applicants for licensure to appear in person for examination; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1308, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1308. A. The applicant for bail bondsman licensure shall be required to ~~appear in person and~~ take an examination prepared by the Insurance Commissioner, testing the applicant's ability and qualifications to be a bail bondsman. Applications are valid for three (3) months after submission. If an applicant has not acted upon the application within that period, a new application and fees shall be submitted for the applicant to be considered for licensure.

B. Each applicant shall become eligible for examination if the applicant has completed sixteen (16) hours of education as required

1 by Section 1308.1 of this title prior to the examination.

2 Examinations shall be held at times and places as designated by the
3 Commissioner.

4 C. The fee for the examination shall be One Hundred Dollars
5 (\$100.00). Results will be provided after the applicant is
6 examined.

7 D. The failure of an applicant to pass an examination shall not
8 preclude the applicant from taking subsequent examinations;
9 provided, however, that at least thirty (30) days shall intervene
10 between examinations; and provided further, after a third or
11 subsequent examination failure, an applicant may not be examined for
12 at least one (1) year after the last examination failure.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
