13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 291, O.S.L.
14	2022 (26 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 6-104.1), is amended to read as
15	follows:
16	Section 6-104.1. <u>A.</u> All ballots used for any election shall be
17	printed on paper to ensure a fair and accurate count; provided, each
18	precinct polling place and in-person absentee voting location shall
19	provide a means for any voter who requires assistance by reason of
20	blindness, disability, or inability to read or write to cast a
21	ballot privately and independently, in a manner to be determined by
22	the Secretary of the State Election Board.
23	B. Any new unitary integrated voter system implemented on or
24	after the effective date of this act shall utilize technology that

1	would provide the voter a unique identifier to allow the voter to
2	track his or her paper ballot online to confirm that the ballot was
3	counted and correctly recorded his or her votes.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2024.
