SENATE BILL 84

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to traffic control signals;
prohibiting contracting for use of photo monitoring
devices; defining terms; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-226 of Title 47, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No state agency, county, municipality, or political
subdivision may contract with any private corporation to provide for
the use of any photo monitoring device to detect any traffic control
signal violation.

B. As used in this section, the term "photo monitoring device"
means a stationary, unmanned device used with a lighted traffic
control device to detect a traffic control signal violation and
captures photographic identification of the vehicle that results in
the issuance of a citation against the registrant, rather than the
driver, of the vehicle.

1 C. As used in this section, the term "traffic control signal"
2 means any device, whether manually, electronically, or mechanically
3 operated, by which traffic is alternately directed to stop and
4 proceed.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
