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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-9-111 of Title 27A, unless
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	On or before January 1, 2025, the Department of Environmental
17	Quality, in coordination with the Office of the Secretary of Energy
18	and Environment, shall conduct a study pursuant to this section.
19	The study shall focus on the feasibility of establishing nuclear
20	facilities to be located in this state. The study shall also
21	include the state requirements as specified by the United States
22	Nuclear Regulatory Commission and any method of federal agency
23	approval. The Department shall issue a report based on the findings
24 27	of the study and shall include any recommendations for the

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1	establishment of a facility. The report shall be delivered to the
2	Governor, the Secretary of Energy and Environment, the President Pro
3	Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
4	the Chair of the Senate Energy Committee, and the Chair of the House
5	Energy and Natural Resources Committee no later than February 1,
6	2025.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
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
