10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2021, Section 4-144, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 4-144. A. No person may hunt or take black bear
14	without having first procured a license from the Director of
15	Wildlife Conservation or an agent of the Director.
16	B. The Wildlife Conservation Commission shall decide the open
17	season, the bag limits, and territorial limitations for hunting or
18	taking black bear.
19	C. The fees for a license issued pursuant to this section shall
20	be:
21	1. For legal residents, One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00); and
22	2. For nonresidents, Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
23	D. Any person who fails to obtain a license as required in
24 2 -	subsection A of this section and pay the fee as required in

¹ paragraph 1 of subsection C of this section, upon conviction, shall ² be punished by a fine of not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) ³ nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in ⁴ the county jail for a period not to exceed six (6) months, or by ⁵ both said fine and imprisonment.

E. Any person who fails to obtain a license as required in
subsection A of this section and pay the fee as required in
paragraph 2 of subsection C of this section, upon conviction, shall
be punished by a fine of not less than Eight Hundred Dollars
(\$800.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or by
imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed six (6)
months, or by both said fine and imprisonment.

F. Legal residents of Oklahoma shall be exempt from the annual black bear license requirements of subsection A of this section provided a legal resident acquires a lifetime hunting or combination lifetime hunting and fishing license pursuant to the provisions of Section 4-114 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
