RESOLUTION 1X

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution relating to adjournment of the Legislature for a period in excess of three days; and providing reciprocal consent of the Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives to adjournment for a period of time in excess of three days for the duration of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Constitution requires the consent of the two chambers of the Legislature to be adjourned for a period of time in excess of three (3) days; and

WHEREAS, it is foreseeable that either the Oklahoma State Senate or the Oklahoma House of Representatives or both chambers of the Legislature may need to adjourn for a period of time of more than three (3) days between the current point of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature and the sine die adjournment of such session; and

1 WHEREAS, in the interest of time and to avoid potential
2 difficulty in obtaining the required assent pursuant to the
3 provisions of the Oklahoma Constitution it is reasonable for the
4 Legislature to provide a continuing permission for either chamber or
5 both chambers to be adjourned for a period of time in excess of
6 three (3) days.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST
8 EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF
9 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

10 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate grants its consent to the
11 Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the Oklahoma House of
12 Representatives grants its consent to the Oklahoma State Senate, to
13 be adjourned for more than three (3) days from the date of adoption
14 of this measure by the chambers or the date as of which the measure
15 is acted upon by the second chamber to consider it, whichever date
16 last occurs.

17 THAT the ongoing mutual consent to adjournment for a period of
18 time in excess of three (3) days as provided by this measure shall
19 continue until this measure is either superseded by other action
20 taken by the Oklahoma Legislature or until the sine die adjournment
21 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature,
22 whichever event first occurs.
