RESOLUTION 2

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution directing the Pentagon and U.S. Department of Defense to not send foreign soldiers to Oklahoma; and encouraging the executive branch and state's law enforcement.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Congress has not formerly declared war as required by the U.S. Constitution regarding the Russian-Ukrainian conflict; and

WHEREAS, the nation of Ukraine and the soldiers of the Ukrainian military are not members of NATO; and

WHEREAS, recent reports indicate the Ukrainian military launched a rocket that landed in Poland, killing innocent Polish citizens, and the citizens of Oklahoma need not be under threat of a similar failure impacting our people; and

WHEREAS, the Pentagon recently announced their intent to send approximately 100 members of the Ukrainian military into Oklahoma to train on U.S. military rocket defenses.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
2 OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
3 CONCURRING THEREIN:

4 THAT the Oklahoma Senate directs the Pentagon, Department of
5 Defense, and federal government to reverse course on their attempt
6 to send foreign troops to Oklahoma.

7 THAT the Oklahoma Senate encourages the executive branch and
8 Oklahoma law enforcement at the state and local level to use all
9 powers delegated to them to keep foreign soldiers off Oklahoma soil,
10 including but not limited to, the detainment of any foreign soldier
11 who leaves a federal enclave into Oklahoma's boundaries.
