11	organizations; celebrating Taiwan Relations Act anniversary; and directing distribution.

14	WHEREAS, the longstanding sister-state relationship, close
15	economic ties, and bonds of friendship between the U.S. and Taiwan,
16	embodied in the Taiwan Relations Act of 1979, continue to yield
17	important economic, social, strategic, and cultural benefits; and
18	WHEREAS, Taiwan ranks as the United States' ninth-largest
19	trading partner, with bilateral trade reaching \$114 billion, and the
20	sixth-largest export market for U.S. agricultural products; and
21	WHEREAS, the robust U.STaiwan trade and investment partnership
22	provides a solid foundation for a mutually beneficial bilateral
23	trade agreement to spur job creation, expand the global market, and
24	secure international supply chains; and

¹ WHEREAS, Taiwan is committed to helping address global ² challenges, from humanitarian crises to nontraditional security ³ threats and pandemic prevention; and

WHEREAS, Taiwanese officials and civil society groups partner with the U.S. on a range of issues to promote our common values of freedom, democracy, and human rights; and

7 WHEREAS, Taiwan is Oklahoma's seventh-largest export partner in 8 Asia, with over \$32 million in goods and services exported to Taiwan 9 in 2022, and the establishment of an Oklahoma Trade and Investment 10 Office in Taiwan could enhance the participation of small- and 11 medium-sized enterprises in trade and investment; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma and the U.S. have benefited immeasurably through decades of unwavering friendship with Taiwan, and the wider world is sure to reap tremendous rewards as Taiwan works to enhance its presence in the international community.
