BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:	
SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 650.6, is	
amended to read as follows:	
Section 650.6. A. Every person who commits any assault upon <u>any</u>	
county commissioner, county clerk, county assessor, county	
treasurer, or any officer of a state district or appellate court, or	
the Workers' Compensation Court, including but not limited to	
judges, bailiffs, court reporters, court clerks or deputy court	
clerks, or upon any witnesses or juror, because of said person's	
service in such capacity or within six (6) months of said person's

service in such capacity, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one (1) year, by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine.

5 в. Every person who commits any battery or assault and battery upon any county commissioner, county clerk, county assessor, county 6 7 treasurer, or officer of a state district or appellate court, or the Workers' Compensation Court, including but not limited to judges, 8 9 bailiffs, court reporters, court clerks or deputy court clerks, or 10 upon any witnesses or juror, because of said person's service in 11 such capacity or within six (6) months of said person's service in 12 such capacity, shall be guilty of a felony punishable by 13 imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not 14 more than five (5) years, by a fine of not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine. 15

C. Every person who knowingly commits any assault, battery or assault and battery upon a process server licensed in this state while the person is in the performance of his or her duties shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one (1) year, by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine.

23 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
