HOUSE BILL 2541

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; creating the State Government Transparency in Billing Act; exempting Legislature and Judiciary from fees and costs for services rendered by state agencies; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 464.2 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "State Government Transparency in Billing Act".

B. Except as otherwise provided by law, the legislative and judicial branches of state government shall be exempt from any and all fees and costs for services rendered by any appropriated state agencies. For purposes of this section, "state agencies" means any office, department, board, commission or institution of the executive branch of state government.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
