7	An Act relating to career and technology education;

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 14-132, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 14-132. A. The State Board of Career and Technology
18	Education is hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreements
19	and to contract for the provision of adult education, assessment and
20	other services for courses leading to a high school equivalency
21	diploma. Any adult education program providing services pursuant to
22	a contract or subcontract with the State Board of Career and
23	Technology Education and receiving funds from the State Board of
24	Career and Technology Education or any contractor with the State

Board of Career and Technology Education shall be subject to the provisions of the administrative rules of the State Board of Career and Technology Education.

B. The Department of Education shall retain the responsibility
for issuing diplomas to those who successfully complete a high
school equivalency test, pursuant to criteria established by the
State Board of Education.

8 C. The State Board of Career and Technology Education is hereby 9 authorized to outline the eligibility criteria, and requirements for 10 individuals 21 years of age and older, seeking to obtain a high 11 school equivalency credential based on their work experience and 12 previous education. 13 SECTION 2.
