HOUSE BILL 3590

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring students in the eighth grade to learn about and memorize the preamble to the United States Constitution; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.16 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Beginning in the 2024-2025 school year, every student in the eighth grade shall learn about and memorize the preamble to the United States Constitution.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
