As used in this section, "premises" means the real property 6 on which a public school is located including, but not limited to, 7 school buildings, grounds, athletic fields, gymnasiums, auditoriums, and parking lots owned or leased for use by the school. 9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024. 10 SECTION 3.
