7	An Act relating to pedestrian safety; amending 47
8	O.S. 2021, Section 11-502, which relates to safety in designated areas; modifying provisions related to
9	crosswalks; repealing 47 O.S. 2021, Section 11-503, which relates to safety in designated areas; and
10	providing an effective date.

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 11-502, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 11-502. (a) When traffic-control signals are not in
17	place or not in operation, the driver of a vehicle shall yield the
18	right-of-way, slowing down or stopping if need be to so yield, to a
19	pedestrian crossing the roadway within a crosswalk when the
20	pedestrian is upon the half of the roadway upon which the vehicle is
21	traveling, or when the pedestrian is approaching so closely from the
22	opposite half of the roadway as to be in danger. This applies to
23	both marked and unmarked crosswalks.

1	(b) No pedestrian shall suddenly leave a curb or other place of
2	safety and walk or run into the path of a vehicle which is so close
3	that it is impossible for the driver to yield.
4	(c) Paragraph (a) shall not apply under the conditions stated
5	in Section 11-503(b).
6	(d) Whenever any vehicle is stopped at a marked crosswalk or at
7	any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection to permit a pedestrian to
8	cross the roadway, the driver of any other vehicle approaching from
9	the rear shall not overtake and pass such stopped vehicle.
10	SECTION 2. REPEALER 47 O.S. 2021, Section 11-503, is
11	hereby repealed.
12	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
