7	A Resolution commending Hmong Special Guerilla Unit (SGU) Veterans; and directing distribution.

10	WHEREAS, Hmong Special Guerilla Unit (SGU) Veterans Recognition
11	Day commemorates Hmong combat soldiers that served under the
12	direction of United States military and clandestine forces from
13	1961-1975, in the Secret War of Laos during the Vietnam War; and
14	WHEREAS, we recognize the contributions Hmong Veterans of
15	America continue to make to keep our cherished liberties alive; and
16	WHEREAS, the Hmong SGU veterans were vital in the Secret War in
17	Laos, providing intelligence and troops to one of the nation's
18	largest operations, rescuing American soldiers, and blocking North
19	Vietnam from using the Ho-Chi Minh Trail to South Vietnam; and
20	WHEREAS, it is estimated that at least 35,000 Hmong SGU veterans
21	were killed during the Secret War, and the remaining Hmong
22	population in Laos have been victims of ongoing retaliation, murder,
23	and genocide since the conclusion of the war; and

1 WHEREAS, on May 14, 1975, the last American Central Intelligence 2 Agency personnel withdrew from Laos, and the Hmong veterans and their families began their journey to new beginnings; and 3 4 WHEREAS, these veterans and their families were provided with 5 political asylum, refugee status, and citizenship because of their unique contribution to the United States. 6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 7 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 8 9 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives recognizes May 15 as Hmong Special Guerilla Unit (SGU) Veterans Recognition Day in 10 11 Oklahoma. 12 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma 13 Hmong Association, President Cher J.
