COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
Commerce; requiring that portions of certain funds be  
utilized for certain purposes; providing budgeting  
and expenditure limitations and procedures; and  
providing for lapse of funds under certain  
conditions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st  
Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of  
One Hundred Forty-eight Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars  
(\$148,650.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive Director  
of Commerce, be allocated to support the International Protocol  
Office within the Department.

1       SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
2 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st  
3 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of  
4 Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) shall, under the  
5 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be utilized to  
6 support geographic information systems (GIS), mapping, and other  
7 technology needs the Department has in supporting its divisions.

8       SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
9 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st  
10 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of  
11 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall, under the  
12 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to the  
13 Agriculture Initiative within the Department. Such funds shall be  
14 used to attract new agriculture industry companies and help support  
15 existing agriculture industry companies.

16       SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
17 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st  
18 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of  
19 One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall, under the  
20 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to  
21 support the Small Business Development Centers. Such funds shall be  
22 used to establish additional centers in areas of the state that do  
23 not currently have a center.

1       SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
2 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st  
3 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of  
4 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall, under the  
5 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to  
6 support Oklahoma Community Expansion of Nutrition Assistance.

7       SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
8 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st  
9 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of  
10 Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) shall, under the  
11 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to  
12 Seminole State College's Rural Business and Resources Center.

13       SECTION 7. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
14 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st  
15 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of  
16 Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) shall, under the direction of  
17 the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to help stand-up  
18 and support the Murray State College's Gunsmithing Technology degree  
19 program.

20       SECTION 8. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma  
21 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st  
22 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of  
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1 Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall, under the  
2 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to  
3 Northeastern Oklahoma A&M Agriculture Rodeo program.

4 SECTION 9. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
5 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
6 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24) or may be  
7 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25).  
8 Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
9 2024, and must be expended by November 15, 2024. Any funds  
10 remaining after November 15, 2024, and not budgeted for FY-25, shall  
11 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
12 year. Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June  
13 30, 2025. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2025, shall lapse  
14 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
15 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
16 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-24, and not required to pay  
17 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-25, after  
18 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
19 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
20 from the FY-24 budget work program and after such revision has been  
21 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
