COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
Veterans Affairs; making an appropriation;
establishing amount; identifying source; providing
purpose; providing for noncodification; and declaring
an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
Veterans Affairs from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 2022, the sum of Ten Million Eight Hundred Sixty-
three Thousand Four Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$10,863,470.00) or so
much thereof as may be necessary to advance the construction and

1 furnishing of facilities to be operated by the Oklahoma Department
2 of Veterans Affairs.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
