COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Legislative Service Bureau;
making an appropriation; identifying a source;
establishing an amount; providing purpose; providing
for noncodification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau
from monies not otherwise appropriated from the ARPA Administrative
Costs Fund created in Enrolled House Bill No. 2940 of the 1st
Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Hundred
Forty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$248,000.00) or so much thereof as may
be necessary to pay obligations that may arise out of contracts

1 during Fiscal Year 2025 related to the American Rescue Plan Act of
2 2021.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
