COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Legislative Service Bureau;
making appropriations; identifying sources;
establishing amounts; providing purposes; providing
for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau
from monies not otherwise appropriated from the ARPA State Fiscal
Recovery Fund (496), the sum of Four Hundred Eighty-one Thousand
Eight Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$481,890.00) or so much thereof as may
be necessary to pay obligations that may arise out of contracts

1 during the Fiscal Year 2023 and Fiscal Year 2024 related to the
2 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
4 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

5 There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau
6 from monies not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery
7 Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled House Bill No. 3349
8 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
9 Fourteen Thousand One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$14,110.00) or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary to pay obligations that may arise out of
11 contracts during the Fiscal Year 2023 and Fiscal Year 2024 related
12 to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

13 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
