COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;  
setting certain budget limits; providing an effective  
date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, the budget  
limit for the Public Utility Division of the Corporation Commission  
shall be set at Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars  
(\$8,500,000.00).

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
