COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
directing transfer of funds; authorizing certain
expenditures; providing purpose; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Director of the Office of Management and
Enterprise Services shall transfer on the effective date of this
act, the sum of Eight Million Eighty-five Thousand Four Hundred
Fifty-four Dollars (\$8,085,454.00) of the funds appropriated to the
Oklahoma Department of Commerce pursuant to Section 1 of Enrolled
Senate Bill No. 6 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 58th
Oklahoma Legislature to the Department of Human Services for
additional funding for the grant program that provides assistance to

1 food programs which support the availability of and access to
2 affordable and nutritious foods.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
