HB 1006, as introduced, requires schools to excuse a student's absence if the student is participating in a scheduled 4-H activity approved by the county 4-H educator. A school principal may require proof of student participation. A student must be given the opportunity to make up any missed class work while participating in an approved 4-H activity and may not have their grades adversely affected for such participation.
