## **Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 1026x adjusts the annual compensation for certain state elected officials beginning January 2025. The Governor is to receive a salary equal to that of the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court. The Attorney General is to receive a salary equal to that of the Presiding Judge of the Court of Criminal Appeals. Additionally, the Lieutenant Governor, State Superintendent of Public Instruction, State Treasurer, State Auditor and Inspector, State Insurance Commissioner, Commissioner of Labor, and all members of the Corporation Commission are to receive a salary equal to that of a district judge.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

There will be no fiscal impact in FY24 as all increases will only occur after the next election for the position which occurs in FY25. From and after the beginning date of a term of office which commences in, or after, January 2025, these executive branch officials shall have their salaries tied to the salaries of the following judicial branch members:

Due to the fact that elected seats are not taken until the January after a given election year, each executive official will collect the salary increase in only half of their first year elected. Also, due to the varying election years for each office, the impact of HB1026x will be felt incrementally until FY30, whereafter the full amount of salary increases will be \$463,147 more per year than they are in FY23, as outlined below:
