**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to House Bill 1382 removes the requirement that subjects the review boards to the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act and exempts post-adjudication review boards from the definition of a "public body." The measure also establishes guidelines for the annual report submitted by the State Post Adjudication Review Advisory Board. Stipulating that the report should include the location, names of members, number of cases reviewed, and recommendation categories of each review board.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1382 removes requirements, makes exemptions, and establishes guidelines relating to certain post-adjudication review boards. The committee substitute removes requirements, and establishes certain exemptions and guidelines. In its current form, the measure merely amends certain procedural elements of existing law; therefore, no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations is anticipated.
