Research Analysis

HB 1424, as introduced, creates an Education Employee Assistance Program within the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for the purpose of helping school district employees with mental health, problem resolution, medical referrals, drug and alcohol addiction, or other personal problems. Participation is voluntary.

Records related to an employee's participation in the program must be kept confidential and kept separately from their personnel file.

The Department of Mental Health is authorized to promulgate rules and contract with other entities to carry out the Program.
