**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 1464 establishes that rural water districts, nonprofit water corporations, and municipal public water systems in municipalities with a population of 25,000 people or less are exempt from having to pay for any expenses related to removing or relocating water facilities in public rights-of-way due to state highway or turnpike construction projects. Currently, the municipal population threshold is 10,000 people.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1464 exempts any rural water district, nonprofit water corporation, or municipal public water system in municipalities with a population of less than 25,000 from paying for any expenses related to removing or relocating water facilities due to state highway or turnpike construction projects. The current population threshold for this exemption is 10,000 people. This measure would have no direct fiscal or revenue impact to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (OWRB). The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) does anticipate a negative fiscal impact for their agency from this measure, but it is pending confirmation of final impact calculations.
