**Research Analysis**

The second proposed committee substitute to HB 1464 establishes that rural water districts, nonprofit water corporations, and municipal public water systems in municipalities with a population of 15,000 people or less are exempt from having to pay for any expenses related to removing or relocating water and sewer facilities in public rights-of-way due to a county road or highway construction project. Currently, the municipal population threshold is 10,000 people.

The measure also establishes that rural water districts, nonprofit water corporations, and municipal public water systems in municipalities with a population of 15,000 people or less and natural gas systems that serve less than 10,000 customers are exempt from paying for costs related to removing or relocating natural gas, water, and sewer facilities in public rights-of-way due to state highway or turnpike construction projects.
