**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB1542 grants civil immunity to any restaurant that donate prepared foods at no charge. A restaurant will not be liable for damages caused by the condition of the donated food unless it is grossly negligent, intentional in its actions or knew or should have known about the condition of the food that resulted in the damages.
