Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1586, allows the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department to enforce an administrative fine for any person who occupies a campsite designated as reserved or who fails to pay the park entry fee. The fines are not to exceed \$50 for a first offense, \$100 for a second offense, and \$250 for third and subsequent offenses. Further, the measure allows the Commission to establish annual single and multi-park parking passes. Single park parking passes are to have a maximum fee of \$20 for residents and a minimum fee of \$75 for nonresidents. Residents 62 years old and over are exempt from the single park parking pass fees.
