**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendments to HB 1596, establishes the Official Advanced Fund (OAF) not to exceed \$5,000 for the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission for the purpose of supplying ABLE agents with money for undercover operations to obtain critical evidence for case presentations.

The measure allows for the fund to be reimbursed from time to time by the filing of proper claims, accompanied by valid receipts for expenditures made, and authorizes the ABLE Commission to prescribe forms, systems, and procedures for the administration of the fund.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB1596 authorizes the ABLE commission to establish official advanced funds in the amount of \$5000. Establishing these funds will not utilize any state appropriated dollars. HB1596 is not expected to impact state revenues or state appropriations. The senate amendment should not change the fiscal impact of the bill.
