**Research Analysis**

HB1618 directs court clerks to use electronic means to inform the district attorney, county sheriff, the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation and Administrative Office of the Court of any notice of hearing for a private process server application. Current law requires the court clerk to mail the notice.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure deletes certain mailing requirements relating to civil procedure, requiring delivery by electronic means or delivering a copy of the notice.
