**Research Analysis**

HB 1660, as introduced, adds clarifying language to Oklahoma Statutes specifying that nothing in this act shall be construed as superseding, preempting, or altering rights and protections afforded under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA). The measure adds definitions for both HIPAA and the HIPAA Privacy Rule.
