**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1682 authorizes distiller licensees to sell spirits at one location controlled by the licensee other than the licensed distillery premises. Such spirits will not be considered cocktails or mixed drinks when mixed with non-alcoholic substances used for on-premises consumption.
