**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1688 defines The Oklahoma Health Care Transparency Initiative aimed at creating a database including ongoing all-payer claims database projects that receive and store data from a submitting entity relating to:

- Medical
- Dental
- Pharmaceutical
- Other insurance claims information
- Unique identifiers
- Geographic and demographic information for covered individuals
- Provider files

The measure requires that the database be administered by the state-designated health information exchange.
