## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1713 creates a penalty of \$5,000.00-\$10,000.00 for any payor per violation to be paid to the Oklahoma Insurance Department (OID). OID will have an increased workload depending on the number of cases that occur because of the change. The fines will help offset any increase in cost to the agency. As OID is a non-appropriated agency, there is no fiscal impact to the state budget.
