Research Analysis

The second proposed committee substitute to House Bill 1808 provides that employees of licensed child care facilities, under the Oklahoma Child Care Facilities Licensing Act, will have their household income exempted when determining eligibility for the Child Care Subsidy Program administered by the Oklahoma Department of Human Services. Additionally, it requires licensed providers to notify the Department of Human Services within 30 days when an employee leaves their employment. The measure stipulates that all other eligibility conditions for the Child Care Subsidy Program outlined in the Oklahoma Administrative Code remain in effect.

Fiscal Analysis

The second proposed committee substitute adds household income exemptions to the eligibility determination process regarding free child care for employees of facilities licensed under the Child Care Facilities Licensing Act. Certain notification requirements are also provided. The second proposed committee substitute does not alter the fiscal impact of the measure.
