Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 1859 requires Service Oklahoma to print all credentials, driver licenses and identification cards within the boundaries of the state by November 1, 2025. In the event of an emergency or if not economically feasible, Service Oklahoma may print outside the state after notice is provided to the Governor, Speaker and President Pro Tempore. The measure allows for the expedited delivery of a credential, driver license or identification card if a \$40 expedited delivery fee is paid.
