## **Research Analysis**

HB 1895 requires the board of county commissioners in each county to give priority to vending facilities operated by businesses whose majority ownership is by one or more veterans. Counties are to provide free of charge the adequate space and necessary utilities to operate the vending facility. Fairgrounds, exposition centers, trade/consumer facilities, parks, golf courses, hospitals operated by county trust authorities, or commissaries for the benefit of persons lawfully confined in the county jail under the custody of the county sheriff are exempt from this measure.
