**Research Analysis**

HB 1908 as introduced, requires all reports authorized by law to be filed with the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, or the Speaker of the House of Representatives to be published on the Secretary of State's website within 30 days of receipt. Confidential information within a report can be excluded or redacted, however the omitted information must be identified by the entity submitting the report. Reports with omitted information must be clearly identified on the website.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1908 requires the Secretary of State to maintain a published record on their website of all reports authorized by law to be filed with the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, or the Speaker of the House of Representatives within 30 days of receipt. The Secretary of State is a non-appropriated state agency. Any additional costs associated with the measure are anticipated to be minimal and absorbed within existing budgetary resources of the agency.
