**Research Analysis**

HB1923, as introduced, amends the civil court fees by increasing the sheriff service fee from \$50 to \$100 and the sheriff fees on court-ordered sales of real property from \$75 to 5 percent of the property sales price.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure increases certain fees collected by the Court Clerks and deposited into the State Judicial Fund (SJF) in civil cases from \$50 to \$100. Based on the 5 year average of the fees collected in these cases, this increase in collections would have a positive revenue impact of approximately \$3,000,000 to the State Judicial Fund.
