Research Analysis

HB 1962 provides that any person 14, 15, and 16 years of age employed on a farm may apply for a farm permit authorizing the person to operate any Class D motor vehicle. The measure provides restrictions on operation of a motor vehicle while in possession of a farm permit.

The Senate amendment restores title.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1962 removes existing provisions relating to special farm permits for 14-year-olds and replaces them with new provisions for different age categories including 14-year-olds. This measure also adds requirements for minors under 16 years old to complete adult supervision hours. In order to implement these changes into their credentialing system and for extra vendor testing to be completed to remain compliant in driver license issuance, Service Oklahoma estimates the total cost to be \$200,000 and would take about four months to complete.

The Senate amendment accepts the restoration of the title, and makes no change in the fiscal impact analysis from the previous House Floor version of the measure.
