**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB1969 allows municipality with less than 4500 people to employ retired police officers without affecting the officer's retirement benefits from the Oklahoma Police Pension Retirement System (OPPRS). Such officers can continue receiving their retirement benefits from OPPRS, but may not reenter the system.
