Research Analysis

The CS to HB 1976 authorizes the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety to:

- perform assessments and investigations into terrorism, threats to public safety, organized crime, criminal conspiracies, or other threats of violent crime;
- collect information concerning individuals believed to be engaged in terrorism, threats to public safety, organized crime, criminal conspiracies, or any other threats of violent crime;
- coordinate with local, state, and federal agencies to protect citizens from terrorism, threats to public safety, organized crime, criminal conspiracies, or any other threats of violent crime by creating a clearinghouse of crime-related information.
