**Fiscal Analysis**

Section 1 of HB 1997 in its current form creates in statute a pilot program the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services adolescent and adult to provide greater access to unserved, lower-income communities.

Section 2 of HB 1997 in its current form appropriates \$25,000,000 in FY-24 General Revenue to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, (ODMHSAS).
