Research Analysis

HB2008, as introduced, changes to the pension eligibility and benefits structure for new hires in the Oklahoma Teachers' Retirement System (OTRS) by:

- allowing members to be eligible for normal retirement after 35 years of service;
- lowering the vesting requirement from 7 years to 5 years;
- establishing a tier benefit formula based on total years of service credit as follows:
 - \circ 1.7% multiplier for those with 5 to 13 years of service;
 - 2.0% multiplier for those with 13 to 25 years of service;
 - 2.1% multiplier for those with 25 to 33 years of service; and
 - 2.2% multiplier for those with more than 33 years of service.

For retired members of OTRS that return to work for a public school, the measure allows a member to return to work after 60 days and replaces the current post-retirement income restrictions as follows:

- \$45,429 for first year of full time employment by a public school;
- \$55,000 for the second and subsequent years.

Finally, the measure provides that the minimum teacher salary schedule is not applicable to teachers that return to work after retirement from OTRS.
